**PERU’S SCHEDULE OF COMMITMENTS FOR
TEMPORARY ENTRY FOR BUSINESS PERSONS**

1. The following sets out Peru’s commitments in accordance with Article 11.4 (Grant of Temporary Entry) in respect of the temporary entry of business persons.
2. Notwithstanding the definition of “business person” in Article 11.1 (Definitions), Peru’s commitments shall not extend to permanent residents of Singapore.

Description of Category	Conditions and Limitations (including length of stay)
A. Business Visitors	
<p><u>Definition:</u></p> <p>Business Visitor means a business person seeking to travel to Peru for business purposes, including for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) attending meetings or conferences;(b) performing commercial transactions¹, but not selling goods or providing services to the general public; or(c) undertaking business consultations concerning the establishment, expansion or winding up of an enterprise in Peru. <p>The primary source of income for the proposed business activity is outside Peru, and the business person’s principal place of business and the actual place of accrual of profits, at least predominantly, remain outside Peru.</p>	<p>Length of Stay: Up to 183 days.</p>

¹ This does not include financial services activities.

Description of Category	Conditions and Limitations (including length of stay)
B. Investors	
<p><u>Definition:</u></p> <p>Investor means a business person seeking to establish or develop an investment in Peru, to which the business person or the business person's enterprise has committed, or is in the process of committing, a substantial amount of capital, established by the immigration legislation.</p>	<p>Length of Stay: Up to 90 days.</p>
