

**DECLARATION**  
**on Partnership between the Eurasian Economic Commission and the**  
**States Parties of the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance**

The Eurasian Economic Commission on the one hand, the States Parties of the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance (the Republic of Chile, the Republic of Colombia, the United Mexican States and the Republic of Peru) on the other hand, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,

Desiring to lay the groundwork for comprehensive cooperation between the Eurasian Economic Union Member States and the States Parties of the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance,

Recognizing the importance of fostering sustainable development of the Eurasian Economic Union Member States and the States Parties of the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance,

Declaring the importance of the role of the Eurasian Economic Union and the Pacific Alliance in the architecture of the modern world economy,

Based on the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union dated May 29, 2014, and the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance dated June 6, 2012,

Highlighting the progress achieved by the Eurasian Economic Union and the Pacific Alliance in providing free movement of goods, services, capital and people,

Reaffirming openness of the Eurasian Economic Union and the Pacific Alliance to cooperation with other countries and integration associations,

Determined to advance dialogue in trade relations and strengthen cooperation between the Eurasian Economic Union Member States and the States Parties of the Framework Agreement of the Pacific Alliance in areas of mutual interest,

**DECLARE:**

1. The commitment to establish solid, productive and lasting ties based on mutual respect, openness, mutually beneficial cooperation and equality.
2. The importance in establishing cooperation ties in economic areas of mutual interest between the Eurasian Economic Union Member States and the States of the Pacific Alliance.
3. The decision to explore mutually beneficial areas of cooperation, including regional economic integration and trade facilitation.
4. The intention to carry out regular meetings between the representatives of the Eurasian Economic Commission and the Pacific Alliance State Parties.
5. The intention to promote contacts between the business communities of the Eurasian Economic Union Member States and the States of the Pacific Alliance and organize trade missions.

The modalities of cooperation between the Parties will be elaborated and agreed on by the Parties.

This Declaration is not an international agreement and does not create any rights or obligations regulated under international law to the Parties and does not impose financial commitment on them.

Signed in Lima on 05<sup>th</sup> July 2019 in duplicate in the Russian, Spanish and English languages. In case of any divergence of interpretation, the English text shall prevail.


